

2017 CPCS Food Drive

It's time once again for the annual CPCS food drive. **The food drive will begin on Monday, December 4 and will run until Monday, December 18.** Last year we collected over 2,000 food items, which is an impressive feat for a school as small as ours. As with last year, elementary homerooms will be grouped with teachers, staff, and high school grades to form teams. This system has created a friendly and spirited competition throughout the school. We will again make donations to two groups this year: The Neighborhood Center in Pierrepoint and Helping Hands in Hannawa Falls.

Teams will have a bin in the high school office where donated goods will be placed throughout the food drive. At the end of each school day, members from the Student Government will count the number of goods gathered. They will then indicate the daily total on a chart. A thermometer showing progress is located above each team bin in the high school office.

The food pantry accepts all donations graciously. However, there are some items that are very much needed: **canned vegetables, canned fruit, tuna, peanut butter, cereal, pasta, spaghetti sauce, tomato soup, baby food and boxed meal helpers.** Anything you can give is very much appreciated. Even just one item makes a difference.

The Student Government is very excited to again sponsor this school-wide effort. The spirit and generosity of the Colton-Pierrepoint community is a great motivator for the group.
